**light. Forgive us and renew our sense of hope, peace, joy, and love, to live more fully in the light of your grace, and welcome the truth of Christ the Lord.**



<sup>5</sup>For every boot of the tramping warrior in battle tumult and every garment rolled in blood will be burned as fuel for the fire.


